3. Course Content

The starting point of the course is the introduction to the category of the archive, approaching different types of archives through the history of the institution and through theoretical approaches that highlight the central position of the archive in the constitution of institutions, culture, politics and consciousness.

The issue of the archive defines modernity in multiple ways and takes on a new impetus at the end of the 20th and beginning of the 21st century in the light of the globalised technological and economic condition and accelerating cognitive capitalism. By examining the archive as the preeminent tool of this condition, we will also study the role of interdisciplinarity and the place of artistic practice within this condition. The means to accomplish this are epistemology, critical media theory and cultural and museum studies , the interweaving of art with systems of knowledge and economy which act as foundations in the effort of art and cultural actors to create new, dynamic and democratic fields of knowledge, experience, affect, consciousness and citizenship.

The issue of the archive will be approached both in its administrative, museum, curatorial and artistic dimensions as well as its important role in the organization and management of cultural institutions, events, events, actions (from the establishment of museums to the organization of festivals) and the intertwining of fields through case studies and relevant exercises.
